Bishops Action Foundation **Public and Patient Engagement Framework** **Update**

Information Gathered

The Bishops Action Foundation has visited twenty one South Taranaki community groups including pre school centres, elderly groups, community boards and groups in areas such as, Waverley, Patea, Manaia, Normanby, Opunake and Eltham.

Twenty five extra groups have requested the questionnaires be sent to them due to their unavailability to meet face to face. This was because either timeframes didn't fit with their scheduled monthly meetings or they wanted to share and talk amongst themselves before sending their information through.

To date an additional twelve hard copy, completed questionnaires, have been received from the general public. Digital information will come through via the TDHB internet site and this will be collected before the report is collated.

Iwi that have engaged in the project requested their feedback be communicated independently and while this information will be in the general body of work it will also be separated allowing Iwi to identify their contribution.

The final report is due on the 29th March. The following outlines the proposed format of the final report:

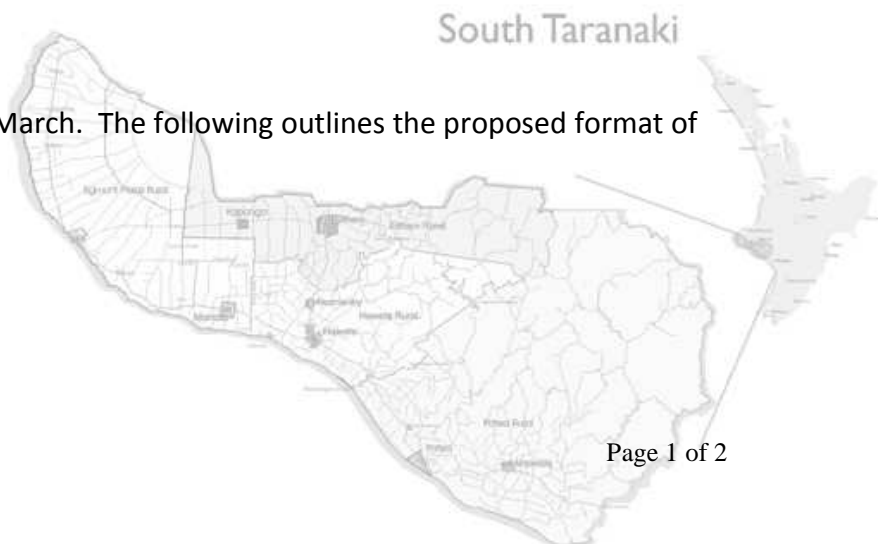


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
