

## **RUN DESCRIPTION**

### **REGISTRAR – ORTHOPAEDICS**

<b>RUN:</b>	Orthopaedics
<b>SITE:</b>	Taranaki Base Hospital
<b>DURATION:</b>	Twelve months
<b>RESPONSIBLE TO:</b>	Clinically: The Consultant(s) on the assigned run. Administratively: RMO Support Unit Manager
<b>NUMBER OF POSITIONS:</b>	Six.
<b>ACCREDITATION:</b>	This run is accredited as a training position with the RACS.

#### **SPECIALTIES COVERED:**

- Registrars on this run provide services principally to the Surgical Wards, Emergency Department, ICU and Dayward. Patients transferred to the Older Persons Health and Rehabilitation Unit are also supervised by the Orthopaedic team.

#### **TEAM COMPOSITION:**

- There are three teams, consisting of Consultants, Two Orthopaedic Registrars and One House Officer

#### **CLINICAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- The Registrar is responsible to their Consultant for the day-to-day clinical management of the team's patients including the admission and clerking of acute patients, attendance at the Consultant ward rounds and routine ward work in conjunction with the House Officer.
- The Registrar should see each of their patients at least once per routine working day. Patients transferred to the AT&R unit remain under the care of the orthopaedic team for their orthopaedic management.
- After hours the Registrar is responsible to the on-call Consultant(s) for all the patients in the Orthopaedic Services.
- The Registrar will consult the Orthopaedic Surgeon on-call by telephone or may call them in to assist.

- Outpatient Clinics will be conducted as required by the Consultants and attendance is required at Outpatient follow-up clinics once or twice a week.
- The Registrar shall be required to assist in theatre with the patients under the care of their Consultants.

**TRAINING AND EDUCATION:**

- Clinical Grand Round – Thursday 1230–1330hrs.
- Weekly Orthopaedic meeting Friday, 0800–0900hrs
- X-ray every third week 1200–1330hrs
- Journal Club once per month

**HOURS OF WORK:**

- Registrars’ ordinary hours are 0730–1600 Monday to Friday.
- Acute cover outside ordinary hours Monday to Friday is provided by call, on a 1:6basis.
- Weekend cover is provided on a 1:6 basis, on duty from 0800–1200 on both Saturday and Sunday followed by call.
- On Call is paid in addition to the base salary as per clause 14 in the collective agreement.
