

## **RUN DESCRIPTION**

### **REGISTRAR – PAEDIATRICS**

- RUN:** Paediatrics
- SITE:** Taranaki Base Hospital
- DURATION:** Six - Twelve months
- RESPONSIBLE TO:** Clinically: the Consultant(s) on the assigned run.  
Administratively: RMO Support Unit Manager
- NUMBER OF POSITIONS:** Four
- ACCREDITATION:** The run is accredited as a training position for specialist qualification for the FRACP as contributing to one year's advanced paediatric training.
- SPECIALTIES COVERED:**
- During the ordinary hours 0800-1600 the Registrar covers the paediatric medical patients on Ward 2B, NNU and Ward 14 and 15.
  - The RMO will consult the paediatrician on call by telephone or may call them back to assist during any after hours shift.
- TEAM COMPOSITION:**
- The Department consists of six Consultants, Four Registrars and Four House Officers.
- CLINICAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**
- Registrars on this run provide paediatric services to the Paediatric ward, Neonatal Unit, ICU, Emergency Department and Outpatients Department under the supervision of the paediatric Consultant staff.
  - The Registrar is responsible to the Paediatricians for the day to day clinical management of the service's including the admission and clerking of acute admissions, attendance at the consultant ward rounds and routine ward work in

conjunction with the House Officer.

- The Registrar should see each of their patients at least once per routine working day.
- The Registrars should be involved in the supervision and teaching of the House Officers and students in the department.
- After hours the Registrar is responsible to the on call Consultant for all the patients under the care of the Child and Newborn Service.
- Outpatient clinics will be conducted as required by the Consultants and attendance at outpatient follow-up clinics once or twice a week shall be as arranged with Consultants.

#### **TRAINING AND EDUCATION:**

- Clinical Grand Round – Thursday 1230–1330hrs.
- The Registrar will attend the regular paediatric X-ray review meeting and the weekly Paediatric Teaching and is expected to present at these sessions from time to time
- Paediatric teaching Thursday 10:00am – 12:00 noon
- The opportunity exists for enrolment for the Diplomas in Paediatrics/Child Health

#### **HOURS OF WORK:**

- Ordinary hours of work are Monday–Friday 0800–1600hrs.
- Long days 1600–2230.
- Nights 2200–0800.
